Section 3, hereby certify that the following is a true copy of the agreement of association to form
said corporation, with the names of the subscribers thereto:

We, whose names are hereto subscribed, do, by this agreement, associate ourselves with the
intention of forming a corporation under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 180.

The name by which the corporation shall be known is
Paralyzed Veterans of America - New England Chapter, Inc.
The location of the principal office of the corporation in Massachusetts is to be the Town or
City of Boston Street V. F. W. Parkway

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows: To promote a closer,
friendlier and more fraternal relationship among its members; developé their eth-
ical consciousness; improve their personal welfare and in general to do everything wi-
thin its power of a civic, educational, charitable and/or benevolent nature to bet-
ter living and medical conditions for all people suffering from spinal cord injuries or
diseases and those effected thereby, directly or indirectly, especially including
and not in limitation of any of the foregoing the right to transact any business
dealings which will enable this Corporation to carry out said purposes; to incur
debts or expenditures, earn profit or solicit funds for the benefit of this Corpor-
ation, to hold, buy or sell real estate necessary for the functioning of this Cor-
poration; to conduct, maintain, supervise or manage advertising campaigns, news-
papers or magazines, periodicals and/or exhibitions for the benefit of those classes
of people outlined above, and to have and exercise all of the rights, powers and
privileges which may now or hereafter be conferred by the laws of Massachusetts upon
corporations formed under Chapter 180 of the General Laws, but these purposes shall
not include the right to apply for a license to sell alcoholic beverages.

We hereby waive all requirements of the General Laws of Massachusetts for notice of the
first meeting for organization, and appoint the 15th day of November, 1956,
at 7:30 o'clock P. M., at Recreation Hall, West Roxbury V. A. Hospital, West Rox-
bury as the time and place for holding such first meeting.
